Program Criteria

- Funds will not be provided for consolidating existing loans or paying off existing business debt. Funds will only be dispersed to local vendors.

Eligibility Criteria

- Start-Ups or Existing Businesses with at least 60% Bahamian ownership.
- Business must be located in New Providence.
- There are no age restrictions on grant recipients.

Application Process

Application Submission

- Application portal will open on June 12th, 2023.
- The deadline for submission of applications via the online portal is 11:55 pm on June 23rd, 2023.
- Applications will be reviewed once the deadline expires.

Decision and Approval

- All completed applications will be scored and reviewed by the Appraisal Committee prior to submission to the selection committee.
- The Selection Committee will review the scores of the Appraisal Committee and determine which applications are conditionally approved and can be processed further. Applicants that are conditionally approved will be required to submit all requisite KYC documents within a week of notification.
- All applicants will receive a formal letter announcing the success or failure of their application. This process will take up to 15 business days after the application period has ended.

3 Disbursement

1. If approved, the grant contract will be sent and a signed copy must be returned to begin the disbursement process.

The applicant must provide the relevant receipts and photos of items purchased or services rendered. Within one (1) month of final disbursement, a bank representative will contact grant recipients to collect impact data.
