Subject: Technology acquisition tender:

1 Background

The primary purpose of the Bahamas Development Bank is to assist in the economic development of The Bahamas by providing financial and technical assistance in areas including Agriculture, Fisheries, Tourism, Industry, Housing and Business Development. For more information see: www.Bdb.gov.bs.

2 Objective of the Assignment/Scope of Work

The Bank is requesting proposals from companies to procure 25 MacBook Pro laptops¹ for creative use. Depending on the individual pricing of the units, The Bank may purchase in excess of this number. The specifications at a minimum should meet or exceed that of the 16 inch M1 MacBook Pro i.e.

The Bank invites eligible vendors to submit competitive quotes for the provision of the devices. Failure to provide a quote that meets the minimum specifications required may lead to disgualification of a bidder from selection.

3 Conditions: information for applicants

To be considered for this tender, interested suppliers must meet the following conditions:

- Compliance with all regulatory standards to act as a licensed company, specifically business license and tax compliance certificate (TCC)
- Experience in computer purchasing and warranty management

Applicants should declare any areas that may constitute a conflict of interest related to this bid.

4 Submission guidelines

Tender documentation should demonstrate that the interested supplier satisfies the conditions stated above and is capable of meeting the specifications and timeframes. Documentation must also include supporting examples to address the evaluation criteria inclusive of the valid quote, including the estimated time of delivery for each item. Prices for the requested goods/services should include all associated VAT, Transport/Distribution Fees, Discounts, or Extra Fees, but priced as a separate line item in the submitted quote. It will be assumed that all quotes will be inclusive of all applicable fees if the bidder fails to separate out these costs. Prices quoted by the Bidder shall be firm and fixed during the Bidder's performance of the final Contract and not subject to variation on any account.

5 Tender Clarification

Any clarification questions from applicants must be submitted by email to sdi@bdb.gov.bs² before the 28th of January 2022. A summary of all questions received with an associated response will be posted on the BDB website www.Bdb.gov.bs/tender by the 2nd of February 2022.

6 Evaluation criteria

BDB will select a preferred supplier on the basis of BDB's evaluation of the extent to which the documentation demonstrates that the tenderer offers the best value for money, and that the tenderer satisfies the following criteria:

- Expertise in technology procurement
- Capacity to manage warranties
- Technology meets the specifications required
