- "List potential competitors for a catering service in Nassau and how I might differentiate."urial journey.

3. Business Model & Value Proposition

Al can help you structure your revenue streams, pricing models, and competitive advantages.

Sample Prompts:

- "Suggest three revenue models for a boutique clothing store."
- "Write a value proposition for a solar installation company that focuses on Family Islands."

4. Financial Planning

While entrepreneurs should always consult an accountant, ChatGPT can help draft the structure of financial statements and guide assumptions.

Sample Prompts:

- "Create a sample cash flow projection for a start-up restaurant with \$50,000 in startup capital."
- "Explain break-even analysis in simple terms and apply it to a retail store example."

(Tip: Pair these AI-generated templates with BDB's downloadable financial resources such as Cash Flow, Profit & Loss, Balance Sheet, and Break-even templates.)

5. Marketing & Sales Strategy

Al can generate ideas for branding, outreach, and customer retention.

Sample Prompts:

- "Write a 3-month social media marketing plan for a new coffee shop."
- "What are cost-effective marketing strategies for a small landscaping business in The Bahamas?"

6. Risk Analysis & Mitigation

Business plans should include risks and solutions.

Sample Prompt:

"List five potential risks for a small eco-tourism venture in The Bahamas and suggest mitigation strategies."

7. Putting It All Together

Once you've gathered sections, ask AI to organize the plan in a standard business plan format.

Sample Prompt:

"Organize my business plan into sections: Executive Summary, Company Description, Market Analysis, Organization & Management, Services/Products, Marketing & Sales, Funding Request, Financial Projections, and Appendix."

Best Practices When Using Al

- Be Specific: The more details you provide, the better the output.
- Iterate: Refine the answers by asking follow-up questions.
- Validate: Always cross-check AI responses with real data and professional advice.
- Customize: Use AI as a starting point, but ensure your business plan reflects your unique vision.
